Beaches

Tresaith – Dogs permitted October to April, dogs allowed on beach to right of slipway in throughout year.
Aberporth – Dogs permitted on Dyffryn beach throughout the year.
LLangrannog - Dogs permitted October to April, designated dog area in Summer.
Poppit – Designated dog area throughout the year.
Cwmtydu – Dogs permitted throughout the year.
New Quay - Dogs permitted October to April, designated dog area in Summer.
Mwnt – No dogs 1st May – 30th September
Penbryn – No dogs 1st May – 30th September

Bwlch Nant yr Arian Forest

Numerous scenic walks through the forest and around the lake, with a very good chance of seeing Red Kites, with daily feeding time at 2pm attracting 30+ kites at a time. Visitor centre with café that allows dogs.

Ceredigion Coastal Path

The Ceredigion coastal path offers 60 miles of coastal walking, giving you the option of short walks or an all day hike. A nice and relatively easy part of the path takes you between Tresaith beach and Aberporth. Dogs are allowed on the Cardi Bach coastal bus, giving you the option of exploring further afield and returning by bus.

Vale of Rheidol Railway

An hours journey each way by narrow gauge steam locomotive through the stunning Rheidol valley from Aberystwyth to Devils Bridge. Dogs travel for £2.50.
